# Hunting in the Czech Republic 2024

Lány state district



#### Size and nature of the territory:

The Lány state hunting ground is probably the richest in game in the Czech Republic. Covering several thousand hectares, it is located in one of the country's most scenic regions. As early as the 18th century, hunts for crowned heads of state were organized in this district and since then statesmen from all over the world have hunted there. It is an exceptional area and only the best experts in the Czech Republic are in charge. The terrain is flat and covered with mixed forests of all ages. The oak trees, some of which are centuries old, are impressive. There are huge thicket complexes and plenty of large resting and resting areas for all the ungulates that occur. A core area in the district of around 3,000 ha is separated from the surrounding forests by a game-proof wooden fence. The hunting ground is criss-crossed by numerous watercourses, lakes and valleys alternate with meadows and large clearings. Areas with very old oak trees have been preserved thanks to centuries of coppicing. Parts of the district resemble a park-like landscape.

Such forest structures are rarely found. Despite and due to the high game population, a special and interesting flora has developed. Other areas of the district are covered with deciduous and younger coniferous forest. Due to the good mixture of beech, oak, maple, chestnut and old pine trees, the game has excellent natural grazing.

#### Game species:

The game species found in Lány include red deer, fallow

deer, mouflon, sika deer (two subspecies) and wild boar. There is also a pheasant farm of around 500 ha. Red deer: Lány is known for its strong red deer. Every year, top-class stags are shot with up to 240 CIC and more. Hunting is certainly most exciting during the rut in September, but during the rest of the hunting season, a big red deer kill is also common.

Fallow deer: The quality and strength of the fallow deer can certainly compete with the best Hungarian fallow deer. Shovelers are regularly shot that exceed the magic 200 CIC limit. These are stags with antlers weighing over 4 kg. The rut is in October and you must register in good time for one of the few free places.

Mouflon: Top rams reach 220 CIC and more. These have slug lengths of well over 80 cm with sometimes very pronounced grooves. Mouflon rams may be shot from October 1 to November 15. Sika deer: Both the Japanese sika and the Dybowski sika are found in Lány. Two very interesting species that can be hunted from September 1st. Lány also occupies a leading position in Europe for sika. Wild boar: The population of sows is very good. Boars can be hunted on individual hunts, otherwise the wild boar population is reduced to driven hunts, which are usually only carried out on a few days in

November. You can imagine what is hunted down when the population is high. You have to register for the driven hunts almost a year in advance as there are only very few places available each year.

#### Accommodation

Our guests can stay in a beautiful hunting lodge next to the hunting ground. The landlady of the house still cooks for the hunters herself and the rooms and catering leave nothing to be desired and are of a high standard. There are 5 rooms at your disposal. Each room also has its own well-equipped bathroom. All in all, a very cozy, hunting accommodation.











#### Location of the hunting ground:

Lany is located approx. 35 km northwest of Prague and is most easily reached by car. From Dresden, for example, it is only 135 km to the 150 km from

Chemnitz and just under 250 km from Regensburg. Except for the last few kilometers, you drive on freeways and well-developed country roads.

#### Arrangement of a single hunt in Lány

- 4 days of travel - 3 nights in standard accommodation in a double room with breakfast - 2 days of hunting organization - Czech hunting license fees - 2 days of guided game drives



Experienced foreign hunters know that the best Czech hunting area is the Lany state hunting area. In order to maintain the high quality of the hunts, only a few hunters are accepted for individual hunts each year. For this reason, early registration is required at Lany. As a rule, 2 full hunting days are enough to get a shot at the desired game. We have had Lany in our

program for many years and therefore have excellent relations with the forestry directorate. All dates are freely selectable, but we coordinate each one with the hunting manager. This way you can be sure that you will hunt at the best time for you. A hunt in Lany has always been something special and is probably a highlight in the life of every hunter.
