Roebuck hunting in Poland 2024
Territory: Kup



Size and nature of the territory:

The Kup State Forestry District is located approx. 15 kilometres north of Opole. The area is steeped in history, as large parts of the district lie on the territory of the former Princes of Pleß. The huntable area is around 24,000 ha and is largely forested. A typical mixed forest district, surrounded by meadows, wasteland and agricultural land.

Location of the hunting ground:

The best way to reach the Kup forest ranger station is by car. If you are travelling via Frankfurt/Oder, it is 355 km to the area on well-maintained roads, 270 km from Forst and 230 km from Görlitz. You can also fly to Wrocław and then hire a reasonably priced hire car. The journey from the airport to the district then takes a good hour (approx. 100 km).

Game species:

Those responsible for hunting are particularly keen to preserve roe deer. Roe deer are found here, which occupy a special position in this region in terms of both carcass and horn weight. If we look at the track lists from previous years, the majority of horn weights are between 200g and 320g. So if you want to hunt good roebucks in a varied landscape, you are in good hands here. In addition to a good game population, you can also expect dedicated and passionate stalking guides and the proverbial Polish hospitality. Please plan your hunt so that you travel as soon as possible after the start of the buck hunt on 11 May until the first week of June or during the leaf season in mid-July/early August.

Shooting fees for roe deer:

The basis of assessment is the weight of the ear with the entire skull, back of the head, nasal bone and upper jaw minus 90 grams.

Roebuck hunting with flat-rate billing

5 travel days - 4 nights in a double room with full board, 1:1 stalking guide, Polish hunting licence, hunting organisation, processing fees, preparation of trophies and shooting of up to 3 roebucks without trophy limit

Each additional roebuck (without trophy limit) will be charged at a flat rate of € 350,00. Welding is considered a kill. Reimbursement of € 200,00 for every buck not shot.

Accommodation: During your hunting holiday, you will be accommodated in an idyllically situated guesthouse in the hunting ground. This is located on the outskirts of the village of Hirschfelde, which, as the name suggests, is situated in the hunting grounds. You can relax here in a cosy and almost family atmosphere after a strenuous day's hunting. There are several well-furnished single and double rooms with en-suite bathrooms available.

Interesting facts:

The Kup Forestry Office is located in one of the most varied regions of Silesia. Nearby are places of interest such as the pilgrimage site of Częstochowa with its famous Black Madonna and the interesting historic centre of Wrocław is also not far away. The local hunters or we will be happy to give you valuable tips.
