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Roebuck hunting in Poland 2024  
District: Obf. Zlotow



### **Location and description of the district**

The Zlotow Chief Forestry Office is located in the middle of the Pomeranian lake district. It lies approx. 35 km north of the town of Schneidemühl. This district was first mentioned in history as the property of the Prussian Hohenzollern princely family. It was first established under the Polish flag in 1945 and had an area of 9,787 ha. Today, the forest administration manages 18,464 ha. The forest area amounts to 17,480 ha. Around 80% of the forest area is divided into 2 large complexes. The first is located in the west and the second in the east of the approx. 527 km<sup>2</sup> area of the Pila Forestry Administration. The forest consists of 60%

The remaining part consists of extensive deciduous and mixed forests with a large proportion of oak and alder. The remaining part consists of many sand plains, moraines and small marshes. The entire area is criss-crossed by rivers, so that a large part of the territory consists of river plains. The huge glacial lakes also cover almost 30 ha of the territory. The terrain is largely flat with slight elevations. There is a 5-hectare nature reserve and around 25 natural monuments in the Zlotow Chief Forestry Office, for example a 500-year-old oak tree with a diameter of 590 cm.



## The roebuck

The annual shooting plan for roe deer in the Zlotow Forestry Office amounts to approx. 140 animals. Around 60 of these are roebucks. The bucks reach an average weight of 250 g to 350 g. However, bucks weighing over 400 g are also shot every year. The Poles are particularly proud of their strict

the Poles are particularly proud of. The roebuck shooting plan stipulates that bucks in the second age class (at least 4 years old) are to be shot first. On the one hand, this results in a good age structure and, on the other, mature bucks are preferred.



## Hunting procedure Hunting procedure

The buck hunt opens in Poland on May 11, when everyone in Zlotow is on their feet. The roe deer are still familiar immediately after the buck hunt begins and the vegetation is not yet so high. However, hunting the abundant roe deer is also particularly promising in the leaf season. As is customary in Poland, stalking is the main activity in Zlotow, although there are also opportunities to sit at strategically good points. Regardless of whether you opt for an exciting stalk or a hide for roe deer, you will definitely have the opportunity to see one or two of the numerous game species in addition to roe deer. In addition to roe deer, the other main game species are roe deer,

fallow deer and wild boar. Your day starts early during the hunt! The first stalk or hide of the day starts as early as 04:45. At around 05:00, just before the first rifle light, you are already on the roebuck hunt. At around 08:00 you enjoy a hearty breakfast in your accommodation. You can spend the time until the evening hunt as you wish, now you have time to really relax. From around 5:30 p.m. you go hunting again. After a successful hunt, you will be back at your accommodation at around 22:00. Once there, our hunting guides will be happy to review the past hunting day with you.





### Accommodation

During the hunt you will stay in a beautiful hunting lodge in the middle of the hunting ground. It is a category “S” accommodation. This means that each bedroom has its own bathroom with shower. The hunting lodge is located in the forest and has several double and single rooms. In the

There is a large dining room in the basement, which is also used as a lounge. The house is furnished to a high standard, clean and very well maintained. You can really relax here and enjoy the excellent Polish cuisine

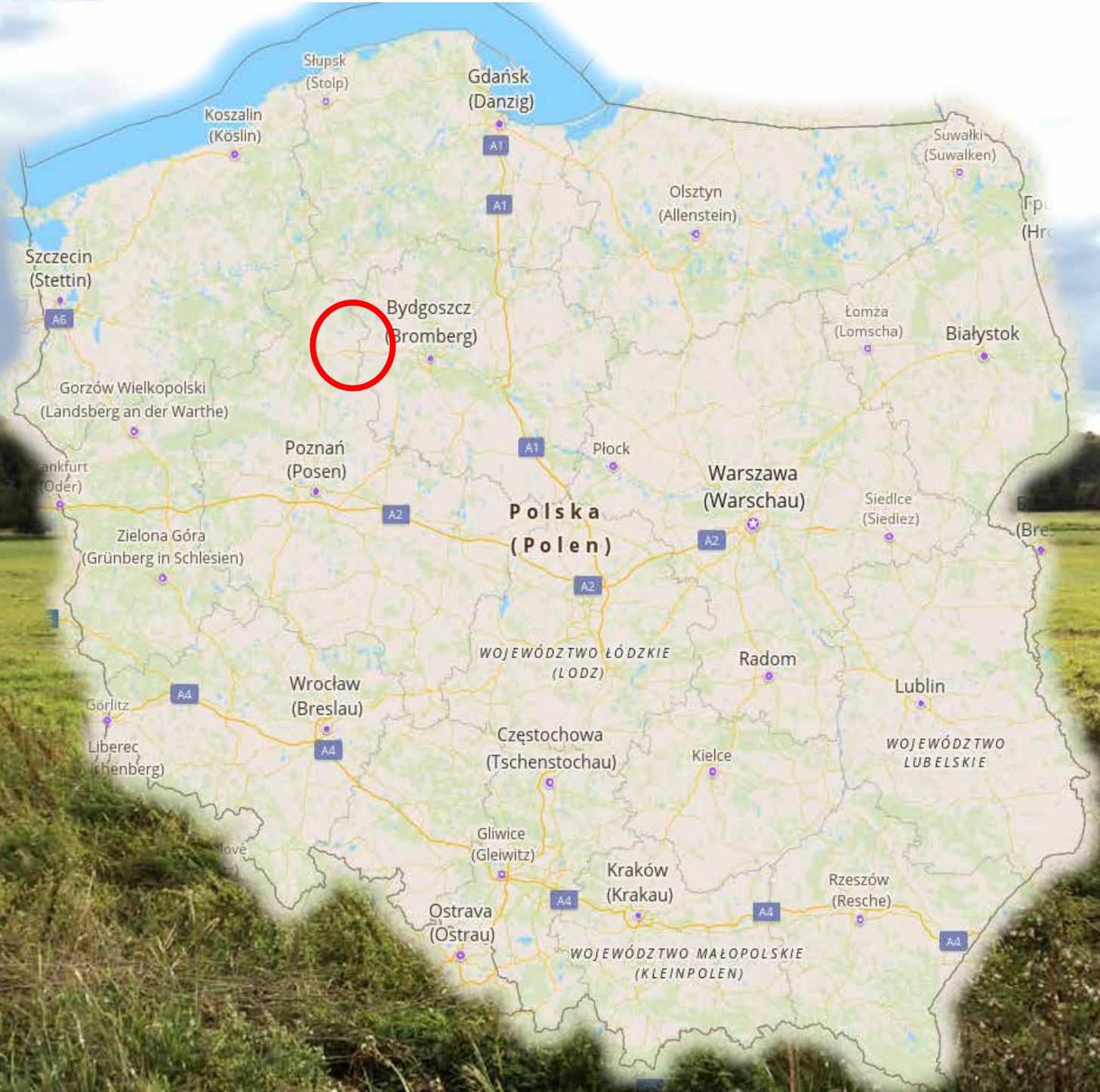

How to get there.

The town is located in the Upper Pomerania region on the left bank of the River Glumia (Głomia), around 30 kilometers north-east of the town of Schneidemühl (Piła) and 110 kilometers north of the city of Poznań. It is very easy to reach from Germany; it is around 190 km from the border crossing in Szczecin and around 250 km from Frankfurt (Oder) to the district.





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
