Hunt Chamois in Slovenia 2024
Hunting Area: Kozorok Kamnik



Size and condition of the area:

The hunting area 'Kozorok Kamnik' is located in the north of Slovenia, in the Steiner Alps. With a size of 43,000 ha, it is divided into 13 sections, which are supervised by experienced professional hunters. The highest elevation is the mountain Grintavec north of Kamnik with 2,558 m. As a rule, chamois are hunted at a height of about 1.800 m, rarely above. It is a varied landscape with light mountain forests, extensive alpine meadows and even rocky regions. Location of the hunting area: Slovenia, became independent in 1991, has been a member of the European Union since 2004 and introduced the euro as a national currency in 2007. Kozorok Kamnik is located in the north, about 30 minutes from Ljubljana airport. By car you are from Munich about 4 h in the area.

Wild species:

Kozorok Kamnik has the largest chamois population in Slovenia. Every year around 340 chamois are being harvested. The hunting season begins on 1 August and

ends on 31 December. The rut falls in November, at this time hunting can become difficult because of the weather conditions. We recommend hunting from August to October. The strongest male chamois was measured with 111 points, the most important female chamois with 109 points. On average, the trophies are between 80 and 95 CIC points. Also the marmot stock in these areas is very good. You can hunt the marmot between 01.09 - 30.09.

Accommodation:

Most guests prefer a rustic hunting hut with self-catering at the chamois hunt. There are over 20 hunting huts, 6 of them are reachable by car. If you want to have it more comfortable, you can stay in one of the guesthouses that lie in the valley. But then a longer journey into the hunting area must be accepted. We know Slovenia and the chamois hunt very well from our own experience. Let us inform you about the optimal travel time, weapons, optics, equipment and clothing.

- 5 travelling days • 4 overnight stays in a hunting hut with self-catering • 3 hunting days • daily hunting fee • organization of the hunt • professional guide • use of all hunting grounds • pre-preparation of the trophy
